How and where to complain

How will your complaint be handled?

Although we strive to provide you with excellent customer service, we understand that issues might arise due to different circumstances. In situations like this, we follow the procedure detailed below:

- We will try and address your concerns immediately. If we are unable to do so,
- We will log your complaint on our system
- We will provide you with a reference number relating your concern
- We will work closely with all relevant departments to ensure that a thorough investigation and resolution takes place
- As soon as we have gathered all relevant information relating to your complaint, we will contact you with a resolution

How long will it take?

We will try to solve your complaint as quickly as possible, however please allow us a minimum of 7 working days to resolve the matter.

If we can't reach an agreement together

We are confident that our complaint resolution process is both fair and robust. However, if we have been unable to provide you with a full and satisfactory resolution, you have the right to refer your complaint to the UAE Central Bank.

Please keep in mind that The UAE Central Bank website states that "Before filing a complaint with the Central Bank, every effort should be made in order to settle the matter directly with the concerned bank or financial institution."
